REPORT

Investigation into this incident continues.

SUNDAY, JANUARY 16TH, 2011

VICTIM VOICEMAIL

At approximately 1143 hrs., the victim left a voicemail message on the detective's desk phone indicating that she wanted prosecution in this matter.

MONDAY, JANUARY 17TH, 2011

VICTIM TELEPHONED

At approximately 0836 hours, Det. Tacey telephoned the victim and a follow-up interview was scheduled for Tuesday, 1-18-11, at 0900 hours at the Ann Arbor Police Department Detective Bureau.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 18TH, 2011

FOLLOW-UP INTERVIEW

Detective Tacey met with the victim at the Ann Arbor Police Department Detective Bureau and conducted a follow-up interview with her at approximately 0900 hours, in interview room #337.

Detective Tacey questioned her about the timeframe regarding her drive from Studio 4 to the suspect's residence. Detective asked her to explain why it took so long for her to get there. The

victim indicated she had gotten lost. She stated she pulled out of the parking structure, made a right, and then made another left, and then she kept on driving. She stated she kept on driving straight and she traveled for what she thought to be over 10 miles. She had [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] on the phone and they were describing their surroundings. She ended up having to make a U-turn upon [REDACTED] instructions and then began to drive back into town. She then used [REDACTED] directions in order to get to the gas station. Once at the gas station, that is when she met [REDACTED] in the gas station. As she was going inside [REDACTED] asked her to get him some Cheeto's. She purchased Dorito's and a juice for herself and the Cheeto's for [REDACTED], and gave them to him.

Detective Tacey asked her to describe how exactly her underwear was removed. The victim stated that when [REDACTED] was over the top of her and began to pull her dress down, he went down to his knees, and as he was going to the knees and pulling her dress, the underwear was grabbed and pulled down to her ankles, along with her dress.

Detective Tacey then questioned her about the different statements regarding penetration at the door and on the bed. Detective was referring to the sexual assault medical screening paperwork that is part of the investigation. Detective confronted her about her stating that she was not penetrated in her vagina when [REDACTED] grabbed her by the door, but she stated that she was during the medical examination.

The victim stated she was penetrated when [REDACTED] reached under her dress, grabbed her buttocks, and her vagina. She stated it was her belief that he placed his middle and ring finger inside her vagina, but not all the way. Detective questioned her about her previous statement that she was touched on the outside of her underwear. Detective asked her if the penetration occurred on the outside of her underwear or on the inside of her underwear, and she stated at this point that [REDACTED] fingers went inside her underwear and penetrated her vagina.

Detective Tacey asked why there is a discrepancy in the two statements. The victim explained she thought the detective meant during his questioning at the hospital penetration required penis/vaginal insertion, and did not realize that digital penetration was part of the questioning.

Detective Tacey then asked her to clarify the statement about lying on the bed and having her vagina touched. The victim stated that [REDACTED] was touching her vagina while she was lying on the bed and he was kissing her breast. He stated he touched her vagina and she was telling him to stop touching her. At this time she does not remember if [REDACTED] actually penetrated her vagina with his fingers.

Detective Tacey asked the victim why she would go back to the residence after the incident that occurred with the codeine cough syrup. The victim stated she trusted him and did not think anything would happen. Detective Tacey asked if she had taken any other drugs that day. Detective referred to marijuana or any form of pills or other substances. The victim stated, "No," and then stated that she went straight to the bedroom when she got into the residence.

Detective Tacey asked if she has ever had sex with either [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] and she stated, "Never."

Detective Tacey then asked her to confirm the identification of the other subjects who were there. To the best of her ability she provided the following information regarding the other potential witnesses.

[REDACTED] Black female, approximately 20 years old. She does not know her last name. Known from Eastern for approximately a year. [REDACTED] and she is not sure if she stays on campus. She has a gold car, maybe an Oldsmobile.
