## REPORT

Investigation into this incident continues.

## STATEMENT OF [REDACTED]

Det. Tacey and witness [REDACTED] had been attempting to contact each other via telephone during the investigation of this incident, but had been unsuccessful. As the detective was traveling to Pontiac, Michigan to interview another witness, a phone call was received, but not answered from [REDACTED]. A few minutes later, Det. Tacey was able to retrieve his telephone and called [REDACTED] back. [REDACTED] stated he was available at this time to talk to the detective, taking into consideration the logistical problems that the detective had in the past to contact [REDACTED] it was decided to interview him on the telephone as the detective was traveling to Pontiac.

The interview started at approximately 1000 hours.

Det. Tacey explained to [REDACTED] why he wanted to interview him. [REDACTED] stated he understood and he

remembered the incident that is being investigated.

Det. Tacey asked who he was with during the time of this incident. [REDACTED] stated that he was with [REDACTED] a person he knows by the name of [REDACTED] and another person that is a friend of [REDACTED] but he does not know him.

Det. Tacey asked what occurred when they were out during this incident. [REDACTED] stated they went out and were drinking. They first went to the bar identified as Fifth Quarter and ended up traveling to Studio 4. They were traveling by way of [REDACTED] vehicle and [REDACTED] was driving.

Once at Studio 4, they met up with the victim, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] saw her in the club with her head lying on a table. [REDACTED] stated that she was "under the influence" and stated it was "obvious."

Det. Tacey asked him to clarify what "under the influence" was and [REDACTED] advised that he could tell she was drinking alcohol and it was affecting her.

[REDACTED] stated he's not too familiar with [REDACTED] and doesn't really know her. He did state that she has a "bad reputation" with male subjects at the university. He explained that she has a reputation of "she'd get around," meaning that she goes out with several male subjects at the university.

[REDACTED] stated they were talking for a few minutes at the club and then they left. Shortly after they left he believes that [REDACTED] must have called her and they made an arrangement to meet. He had heard that she indicated she was "a little tired" and it was agreed up on for her to come on over to [REDACTED] residence.

They eventually met at the gas station and went inside to buy some snacks.

Det. Tacey specifically questioned [REDACTED] that while he was in the gas station with [REDACTED] and the other subject, if a conversation came up about [REDACTED] spending the night at [REDACTED] residence and he stated, "no."

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was with two other girls, one he knows by the name of [REDACTED] and the other one he does not know.

Eventually the group arrived at [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] stated they were sitting around in the living room "chilling" and watching TV. Eventually there comes a time when [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] go upstairs, but he does not know the specifics on how this occurs. [REDACTED] was sitting at the table, which is by the living room, and near the kitchen area. He stated he was sitting there and was drinking some 1800 Tequila.

Det. Tacey asked where the alcohol had come from and he believed that [REDACTED] had brought it over.

[REDACTED] stated that the girl he knows as [REDACTED] went upstairs while the other three subjects were up there. She then returned a short time later and she was on the phone. She then returned back upstairs, came down, and talked to the other girl. Shortly after that, they left the residence.

[REDACTED] stated that he then went upstairs and observed the guest bedroom door was closed. He went over to the door and peeked underneath the bottom edge of the door in between the door and the carpet. He stated he did this because "I was curious what was going on."

[REDACTED] stated that he could see [REDACTED] feet and indicated by the way they were positioned "she might have been sitting on his lap."

Det. Tacey asked who's lap she was sitting on, and he stated [REDACTED].

Det. Tacey asked how does he know for sure that it was [REDACTED] and he stated that is what he thought, but it was the person who was wearing the black Prada shoes. [REDACTED] stated he was looking under the door for less than a minute or two. He stated that he could hear [REDACTED] laughing inside the bedroom.

Det. Tacey questioned him specifically on why he went and looked underneath the door. Det. Tacey asked if he was trying to see if the subjects inside were having sex, and [REDACTED] responded, "I wanted to see what was going on."

[REDACTED] then stated he went outside to smoke a Black and Mild. He was out there with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and eventually [REDACTED] friend, who upon further conversation he believes to be [REDACTED] came out. [REDACTED] stated he was outside for approximately 5 to 10 minutes and then added 15 minutes at the most, and then he returned back inside. When he came back inside he observed [REDACTED] come down from upstairs. [REDACTED] is sitting at the table at this time. [REDACTED] asked if he is ready to go, but they do not leave at this time.

A short time later [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] come down from upstairs. They then began to stay in the living room with everybody else and a lot of talking going on. [REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] is "all over [REDACTED]" meaning that she is close by him and wants to be near him. During part of this conversation he hears [REDACTED] state "all she wants to do is meet [REDACTED]" [REDACTED] states, "What about [REDACTED]" indicating he knows [REDACTED] who is a basketball player for Michigan State University. [REDACTED] indicates she does not know who that is.

At this point [REDACTED] starts calling her a groupie, meaning a female who wants to constantly hang around with people of a specific organization, in this case basketball players. [REDACTED] becomes upset at this point.

The conversation then turns to where all the male subjects are talking to her about being with a guy who was identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] gets upset about this conversation. She then starts saying that she does not have to explain herself to the group, and becomes very vulgar as she is explaining that. She further stated that "you don't understand," and states "don't judge me." She wasn't yelling, but she was raising her voice. She eventually did calm down.

[REDACTED] then stated, "she got to go, she can't stay here."

Det. Tacey asked if he recalls [REDACTED] taking any pictures during this time. He stated he does not recall that and he was sitting on the table.

Det. Tacey asked him how much he was drinking and he said he had some shots. Det. Tacey relayed the story about a person taking the 1800 Tequila bottle upstairs. [REDACTED] stated that was not him, and he does not recall anybody doing that.

Det. Tacey asked him to explain what is meant by her being under the influence, and how she was acting. [REDACTED] stated the victim was falling over and that when he first saw her, she was lying her head on the table in the bar as if she had been drinking. He further stated that she was loud and her general appearance and "slouchiness," referring to her posture was an indication to him.

Det. Tacey asked [REDACTED] if there was any time that [REDACTED] or [REDACTED], talked about having sex while they were upstairs. [REDACTED] stated no, but [REDACTED] referred to [REDACTED] as Kat Stacks and [REDACTED] did not appreciate that.

Det. Tacey asked about the time frame they got to [REDACTED] residence and [REDACTED] estimated

between 0230 hours and 0300 hours.

Det. Tacey asked what time did they leave the residence and [REDACTED] knew that he left at approximately 0500 hours.

Later, [REDACTED] called the detective and wanted to advise him that he had driven his own car, he believes [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had drove a car there together and [REDACTED] had drove his own car there. He indicated when they left [REDACTED] was not in any of those vehicles. It was his belief that after they left, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] to her residence, but he believes that [REDACTED] wanted to stay at [REDACTED] place.

Det. Tacey asked if he observed [REDACTED] drink any alcohol, take any pills, smoke any substances, or take any other controlled substance and he stated no.

Det. Tacey asked what was [REDACTED] mood when she came down from the upstairs. He stated that she was laughing, playing, and "under him" referring to [REDACTED]. Det. Tacey asked him to clarify what does "under him" mean and it was determined that it meant that she wanted to be around him and have his attention.

Det. Tacey asked who he talked to about this incident. [REDACTED] stated he has talked to [REDACTED] about it and their consensus is that it is "unbelievable," that this is occurring. He stated considering it involves [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] they are surprised because they are both good people.

[REDACTED] also stated that he "politely" talked about it with [REDACTED] on Saturday and [REDACTED] was frustrated by the situation.

Det. Tacey asked if he spoke to [REDACTED] about it and he stated no.

Det. Tacey asked if he talked to [REDACTED] about it and he stated that he hasn't talked to [REDACTED] and has no reason to talk to her as they are not that well acquainted.

The interview ended at approximately 1023 hours.
