REPORT

Detective Tacey and Det. Lencloni traveled to the residence of ██████████
██████████ Pontiac, Michigan, to interview him by appointment.

Detectives arrived on scene at approximately 1101 hours. There the detectives met with H ██████████
mother, MRS. ██████████ and explained to her and A ██████████ about the interview. Detectives were
able to interview ██████████ by himself at the kitchen table in the kitchen of their residence. Detective
Tacey informed ██████████ that it was in reference to an incident that happened late January 14th into
the early morning hours of January 15th. ██████████ indicated he recalled the incident. At
approximately 1105 hours, the interview began. Detective Tacey identified ██████████ by way of his
Michigan identification card:

Detective Tacey asked ██████████ how he knew ██████████. He stated he has known him for
approximately 10 years. They played on an AU basketball team together in Pontiac. Detective asked
why he was in Ann Arbor during this timeframe. ██████████ stated he was there to celebrate his
birthday, which occurred on January 18th. He stated he is not too familiar with Ann Arbor, but he
has been out there with ██████████ approximately 10 times.

Detective Tacey asked who he was with during the time of this incident, and he indentified subjects
by the names of ██████████ and ██████████. He does not know these subjects.

They are friends of [REDACTED] from the Eastern Michigan University area.

Detective Tacey asked what occurred during the night that is under investigation.

[REDACTED] stated he went out with the group and they went to clubs. He stated one of the clubs was Studio 4, and he believed that to be around 0100 hours. While there, the group met up with a girl whom he identified as [REDACTED]. Later upon questioning, detective had [REDACTED] describe her. He stated she is a light-skinned black female with long hair, approximately 5'4" to 5'5", thin build. He stated this was the first time he had seen her, but if he saw her again he thinks he would be able to identify her.

[REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] knows this girl and they began talking.

Eventually they left the bar. [REDACTED] stated they did not stay long and he believes they left around 0145 hours. After they left, the girl, whom he described, was calling [REDACTED] on the phone. She was invited over to [REDACTED]'s residence, but she could not find it. They ended up meeting her at the gas station, which [REDACTED] described as a Shell gas station close to [REDACTED] apartment.

Upon arrival at the gas station [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] go inside to buy some snacks. During this time a car pulls up and [REDACTED] exits the car and she is the driver of the car. She goes into the gas station and asks him and [REDACTED] to buy her some chips and juice, and [REDACTED] complies.

Detective Tacey asks specifically that while they are in the gas station does the conversation come up with [REDACTED] asking and [REDACTED] agreeing to have her spend the night, and [REDACTED] indicated no.

After they exit the gas station [REDACTED] follows them to [REDACTED]'s residence, along with two other girls, whom he does not know.

[REDACTED] pulls into the garage and eventually everyone enters into the apartment.

[REDACTED] indicates that he, [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] are sitting at the dining room table. The two girls and [REDACTED] go sit on the couch and loveseat in the living room.

At this time [REDACTED] indicates he gets on the computer and starts to use it. There comes a time when [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] go upstairs, but he does not know when that occurred. He was not paying attention to that.

A discussion occurs between the other male subjects that are downstairs about ordering pizza. They tell [REDACTED] to get online to find the phone number to Pizza House. He calls Pizza House to order a pizza and as he is on the phone he walks upstairs. When he walks upstairs he looks to his right and the guest bedroom door is open. He observes that [REDACTED] is sitting on the foot of the bed. [REDACTED] is standing right in front of him, and [REDACTED] is sitting on the side of the bed. [REDACTED] indicates they are engaged in a "normal conversation" and they are laughing, although he does not know the content of the conversation.

[REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] how he wants to pay for the pizza and [REDACTED] states cash. [REDACTED] then goes downstairs.

Detective Tacey asked what the timeframe was that this occurred. [REDACTED] indicated from the time they entered the residence to the time that he went upstairs was approximately five to 10 minutes. He believes they arrived at the residence at approximately 0200 hours.

Detective Tacey asked him to be specific about what they were talking about. [REDACTED] stated they were up there "messing around." Detective Tacey had him define "messing around." [REDACTED]

indicated they were just laughing and talking, and upon further questioning, it was nothing of a sexual nature.

██████████ stated that after he came down, he believes that both of the girls went upstairs to check on ██████████. Detective Lencioni asked if he knew that for certain. He indicated it was just an assumption. He did not say anything to them, and they did not try to talk to him. They did not know these girls or the other subjects who were at the scene, which is why he did not talk to them. He stated that the other two girls stayed at the residence for approximately 30 minutes and then left ██████████ there. He does recall that the one girl, whom he believed to be the driver when going home, was asking where her keys were, because ██████████ drove to the residence and had the keys. The keys were located on the table.

██████████ stated that after the girls left, a short time later ██████████ came down and stated that everything was alright.

██████████ then came down the stairs and ██████████ asked him, "What happened?" ██████████ responded, "She wanted ██████████." Detective Tacey asked ██████████ to define what "wanted" meant. Detective asked if it was in reference to anything of a sexual nature, and ██████████ stated he did not know.

██████████ then stated ██████████ sat around the table with the rest of the guys.

██████████ indicated that the whole process of people going up and down the stairs after he came down took approximately 15 to 20 minutes.

Approximately 25 minutes later, ██████████ and ██████████ came down the stairs. They sat in the living room and were having conversations with the other males, whom he identified as ██████████ and ██████████. ██████████ indicated that he was not really paying attention to these conversations since he does not know the subjects involved, and that he was on the computer. ██████████ indicated that he did hear ██████████ saying something in regards to her and ██████████ doing something of a sexual nature. ██████████ responded back by saying, "Don't be telling us your business."

It was around this timeframe that the pizza arrived. Upon questioning, ██████████ estimated it to be around 0300 hours.

██████████ then continues talking to ██████████ stating she is a groupie for rappers, indicating a person who hangs around a specific group of people in order to obtain sexual or other favors from them. ██████████ responded, "I'm not a groupie, I just like their music."

Detective then asked ██████████ if ██████████ was specifically mad, and he stated no. Detective asked if she was upset, and he stated no. Detective asked if she was yelling, and he stated no. Detective then asked him to describe ██████████ and he stated, "Normal." Detective asked if she seemed in distress, and he stated no.

During this time the subjects eat their pizza and he believed it to be approximately 30 minutes.

The male subjects from EMU end up leaving the residence.

Detective asked if before they left the residence did ██████████ ever use her phone to take a picture, and he stated no. Detective asked if he had ever seen ██████████ with ██████████ phone, and he stated no. Detective Lencioni asked if ██████████ ever mentioned anything about having ██████████ introduce her to ██████████ and ██████████ stated, "No, not that I recall."

Detectives asked if there was any talk by ██████████ of rape, "this not being right," or contacting the police, and ██████████ indicated no.

After the EMU subjects left, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she should call herself a ride, and stated, "You got to go. You can't stay the night."

[REDACTED] told [REDACTED], "You bold," and then advised him that she did not have his keys. Detective Tacey asked what does [REDACTED] think she meant by [REDACTED] saying, "You bold." [REDACTED] stated he got the impression that [REDACTED] thought she was staying the night. Detective asked if she was mad about that, and [REDACTED] described it more of her being disappointed.

They then got into [REDACTED] car and [REDACTED] was driving with [REDACTED] in the front passenger seat and [REDACTED] in the second row of seats. [REDACTED] stated they drove for approximately 15 minutes to Ypsilanti with [REDACTED] giving him directions.

During that time detective asked what the conversation was in the vehicle. He stated there was no conversation. Detectives advised him that they have talked to several people regarding this matter, and it was their belief there was a conversation, and [REDACTED] stated he does not remember any. Detective then asked if he had seen [REDACTED] with [REDACTED] phone during that time, and he did not.

They dropped [REDACTED] off at her residence and they went back to [REDACTED] apartment. Detective Lencioni asked what was the conversation in regards to going back to [REDACTED] apartment, and [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] "Did you do it?" Upon questioning, the definition of "it" refers to sexual intercourse. [REDACTED] responded no, [REDACTED]

Detective Tacey asked how he heard about this investigation, and [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] called him on Sunday. He asked him to come over to his parent's residence where he talked to [REDACTED] and their attorney. It was there he explained to him that [REDACTED] was saying that [REDACTED] had sexually assaulted her.

Detective Tacey asked how much he had to drink during the night, and [REDACTED] stated he bought one drink at the club and had nothing else. Detective Tacey questioned him about the 1800 tequila bottle, and he stated that nobody had it. Detective Tacey questioned him about the incident with the person going upstairs with the 1800 tequila bottle to give a drink to [REDACTED], and he stated he does not recall that happening, and he was not the person who went upstairs.

Detective asked how much [REDACTED] had to drink, and [REDACTED] stated nothing, and that no one was drinking at the residence when they returned back from the club.

Detectives asked how much they had to smoke, and [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went out to the car and smoked while the subjects were upstairs.

Detective Tacey asked if he saw [REDACTED] drink, smoke, or do any other form of controlled substance while she was at the residence, and he stated no.

Detectives asked if he has talked to any of the other guys or [REDACTED] regarding this incident, and he stated he has not, because he does not know them.

The interview ended at approximately 1145 hours, and Det. Tacey provided [REDACTED] with his business card so he could contact the detective if he had any further information regarding this incident.
