IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants University of Michigan and the Board of

Regents of the University of Michigan are dismissed from Counts III and V of Plaintiff's First

Amended Complaint based on invocation of 11<sup>th</sup> Amendment immunity.

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants acting in their official capacities Mary Sue Coleman,

Rachel Goldman, Tresa Pollack and Peter Green only are dismissed from Counts III and V of

Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint except to the extent that Plaintiff seeks prospective, non-

monetary relief pursuant to the doctrine set forth in Ex Parte Young, 209 U.S. 123 (1908).

IT IS ORDERED that Defendants University of Michigan and the Board of Regents of

the University of Michigan and acting in their official capacities Mary Sue Coleman, Rachel

Goldman, Tresa Pollack and Peter Green waive rights to adjudicate Counts IV and IX in State

court and consent to federal court jurisdiction.

IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff has leave to file the attached Second Amended Complaint

reflecting the above changes and adding certain factual allegations.
