3 THE COURT: And we're on the record in State versus
4 Michael Dwayne Thomas, U of M number 11-1855. Good morning.
5 Can you state your name please and be sworn?

6 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: Yes, your Honor. Detective Ryan
7 Cavanaugh.

8 THE COURT: Could he be sworn?

9 THE BAILIFF: Do you solemnly swear or affirm to tell
10 the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth?

11 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: I do.

12 THE COURT: And Detective Cavanaugh, you're with the
13 University of Michigan Department of Public Safety?

14 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: That is correct, your Honor.

15 THE COURT: And what's the basis for your complaint
16 against Michael Thomas?

17 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: On June 24th of this year at
18 approximately 6:40 p.m., University of Michigan police
19 officers were sent to the U of M Hospital cafeteria area to
20 investigate a possible armed robbery, at which time, upon
21 contact with the victim, Mr. Galbreath, he reported that while
22 he had five money bags in his hand an unknown black male with
23 a disguise on approached him at a fast pace and had a --

24 THE COURT: Hold on, hold on a second.

25 Mr. Oblak and Mr. Bankhead, can you go and talk in

1 the other -- in the anteroom? Thank you.

2 MR. OBLAK: I apologize, your Honor.

3 THE COURT: He approached him?

4 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: He approached him at a fast
5 pace with a stun gun or taser in his hand that was -- actually
6 the victim could see the electrical current, at which time the
7 victim reported that he was tased or stunned by this stun gun,
8 at which time he fell to the ground. He grabbed the suspect's
9 legs in fear, at what time the suspect then began to kick the
10 victim in the head numerous times. The suspect then fled,
11 took flight, at which time our investigation discovered
12 surveillance footage of the incident. A third-party manager,
13 who is not a victim or part of this incident, identified --
14 positively identified the suspect in the video leaving the
15 site of the assault as Michael Dwayne Thomas, a former
16 employee of that location. Mr. Thomas was then taken into
17 custody three days later, at which time he is currently being
18 held.

19 THE COURT: I do find there is probable cause to
20 believe that the defendant listed on the complaint committed
21 the offenses listed therein. Accordingly, the warrant -- the
22 complaint is authorized and the warrant is signed.

23 I just need your signature, Detective Cavanaugh.

24 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: Thank you, your Honor.

25 THE COURT: Thank you. You'll take that out to the

1 Service Center?

2 DETECTIVE CAVANAUGH: Yes.

3 THE COURT: Thank you. Glad you got 'em.
