I have reviewed UMDPS report 08-1400. Based upon that review, I have declined to authorize a criminal charge against _____ There is insufficient evidence to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that _____ intended to impede, interfere with, prevent, or obstruct a witness from testifying or to impede, interfere with, prevent, or obstruct an official from fulfilling his/her duties. Your report lists U-M's online directory lists

However, your investigation has revealed that the University of Michigan Hospital (also referred to as the University of Michigan Health System) has a policy to be less than forthright or cooperative with law enforcement. Moreover, your report contains several references to suspected crimes, or other possible criminal activity, having been committed at the University of Michigan Hospital where hospital security, apparently acting on the advice of general counsel, has failed to notify law enforcement. Hospital security's failure to report the suspected crimes or other criminal activity raises serious questions as to whether the University of Michigan Hospital is complying with the Clery Act requirements for disclosure of crime statistics.
